We will be open as a Church World Service/Lutheran World Relief **drop-off depot** in March and April.



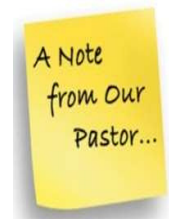

### FROM PASTOR JACKIE TWEDELL WOODS



March 5 marks the beginning of Lent. Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent, is a somber day in the life of the church. It is the day where we remember our humanity and our mortality. It is a day where we claim together the fact that we will all die, as we proclaim, "Remember that we are dust, and to dust we will return." If you would like to begin your Lenten journey with the imposition of ashes, you are invited to join me in the Sanctuary on **Wednesday, March 5**, between 12:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. for a scripture, a prayer, and ashes on your forehead as we remember together that we are dust.

This somber start to the Lenten season reminds us that Jesus' journey to the cross was not an easy one. We, who journey with him, take these 40 days as a time for repentance, introspection, moderation, giving up of bad habits, or taking on new spiritual disciplines. Mostly, though, this year at Bethany Christian Church, we spend this season in prayer and reflection and will do so with Jesus at the table, and we will feast on His words.

This Lent, you are invited to join us as we gather around the Table with Jesus. During the six Sundays of Lent, we will take some time to feast on some of the beloved stories of Jesus at the table. Each week, as we take our place at Jesus' welcome table, we will be nourished...we will be fed...we will gather in his presence and drink deeply of his wisdom.

March 16	The Welcome Table (Matthew 9:9-13)
March 23	Surprised by Grace (Luke 7:36-50)
March 30	Making Room at the Table (Luke 14:7-14)
April 6	Empty Chairs at the Table (Luke 14:15-24)
April 13	A Meal with Chosen Family (John 12:1-19)
April 20	Revived by the Breaking of Bread (Luke 24:13-35)

In addition to our Sunday worship during Lent, we will be continuing our Lenten Lunches, gathering at 11:30 a.m. **every Wednesday of Lent** (March 5, March 12, March 19, March 26, April 2, and April 9) for a BYO-lunch/bag lunch meal. Each week we will eat and share in fellowship and reflect on the scriptures and theme of the week.

I hope you will join us as we gather together at Jesus' table. I hope that these table stories draw us all closer to Jesus and to one another as the body of Christ and that we will all be able to recognize Him in the breaking and sharing of bread.
