COST OF SANCTUARY ARRANGEMENTS ON SUNDAY MORNINGS



Coleman Brothers Flowers informed us that, **effective September 1, 2025**, the cost of a regular arrangement that they deliver to us for our Sunday Worship services will increase from \$26.00 to **\$34.50** (\$27.50 for the arrangement + \$7.00 delivery charge). We have been paying \$26.00 per week for a little over seven years, so to us this seems like a large increase, but this cost is still a bargain for arrangements such as ours.
